

PATTERN INFORMATION:

HAT

Yarn:

246 yards DK weight

Materials:

- US #5 (3.75mm) and US #7 (4.5mm) knitting needles
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker

Size:

19" circumference, unstretched. 8.5" high without pompom.

Gauge:

19 sts x 25 rows= 4" in stockinette in the round with larger needles

Abbreviations:

sts = stitches

CO = cast on

k = knit

p = purl

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together; single right-leaning decrease

With smaller needles, using a long tail cast-on, CO 100 sts. Join to work in the round being careful not to twist. Mark beginning of round with stitch marker.

Pattern:

Ribbing

Round 1: [K1, p1] around.

Repeat round 1 until work measures 1.5", switch to US #7 needles.

Hat

Knit each round, until stockinette section measures 6".





Learn to Knit: Multi Stitch Hat

Pattern:

Decreases

Round 1: [K8, k2tog] around. (90 sts)

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: [K7, k2tog] around. (80 sts)

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: [K6, k2tog] around. (70 sts)

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: [K5, k2tog] around. (60 sts)

Round 8: Knit.

Round 9: [K4, k2tog] around. (50 sts)

Round 10: Knit.

Round 11: [K3, k2tog] around. (40 sts)

Round 12: Knit.

Round 13: [K2, k2tog] around. (30 sts)

Round 14: Knit.

Round 15: [K1, k2tog] around. (20 sts)

Round 16: Knit.

Round 17: K2tog around, finish by breaking the yarn and threading it through all the stitches on the needle. (10 sts)

Weave in ends and block.
